### Renovation, Remodeling, and Painting Rules

#### What are the rules?

##### Lead Renovation Remodeling & Painting Rule (RRP)

- Renovator Certification for those who do work on “target properties.”
- Requires 8 hour training course and exam.
- Certification for individuals and firms by submitting application to the Iowa Department of Public Health is required under EPA policy . We will have those applications available during class.

#### Where do I start?

##### Get Trained:

- Contact your community college to find LSR course as it is an Iowa Approved Training Provider.
- If you already have Lead Safe Work Practices (LSWP) training IDPH will allow you to grandfather into the Renovator Certification with a 4 hour upgrade course.

##### Get Informed:

- RRP Certification requirements go into effect April 22, 2010.

#### Who Needs to know?

Anyone who does work on Properties built before 1978 **MUST** follow Iowa Lead Regulations.

Includes:

- Residential Properties
- Child occupied facilities

Applies to but not limited to:

- General Contractors
- Painter, Plumbers, Electricians, Landlords
- Self-Employed Handymen
