The Beda Sampson Scholarship is provided by the Hannah Marie Foundation\* sponsored by the Hannah Marie Country Inn, Spencer, Iowa. The Scholarship's purpose is to improve employment skills by encouraging non-traditional students to pursue careers in health care. Proceeds will be split equally between two terms of study and may be used for tuition, fees, or books. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be currently enrolled or accepted into the Pre-Practical Nursing, Practical Nursing, Extended Practical Nursing, Associate Degree Nursing, Pre-Radiologic Technology, Radiologic Technology, or Health Information Technology program.
2. Must be 25 years or older.

3. Preference will be given to a resident of Clay County, Iowa.
  
4. Applicants must not be an employee or relative of the Hannah Marie Foundation Board, Hannah Marie Country Inn, the Nichols' family, or the selection committee.
