Jan Snyder, Vice President of Institutional Advancement & Enrollment Services, stated, "We wanted the determination of our mascot to be an all inclusive process. This decision will affect current students, future students, staff, faculty, alumni and the citizens of Cherokee, Lyon, O'Brien, Osceola and Sioux counties. The top three suggestions were gathered over the course of the year. Suggestion boxes were placed on campus and at community home shows and fairs. We also asked NCC alumni, through the College's student newspaper the *Collegian*, to email their suggestions to us."

Dr. Bill Giddings, NCC President, said, "As NCC grows and develops by adding more programming, both technical and transfer, and with the additions of two new residence halls and the opening of the new Lifelong Learning and Recreation Center, we need to branch out and start developing more of a collegiate atmosphere.
